NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES—

In case of work-related injury, your employer has provided for the payment of Benefits under the Workers' Compensation Act of Pennsylvania. If you suffer a work-related injury, _____ or its insurance company must pay for reasonable surgical and medical services and supplies, orthopedic appliances and prostheses, including training in their use.

In order to ensure that your medical treatment will be paid for by your employer or their insurance company, you **MUST** select from one of the licensed health care providers listed below:

***In the event of injuries that are life - or limb-threatening, or cardiac arrest (heart attack) DIAL 911**

If you have a work-related injury, you must visit one of the listed health care providers for 90 days from the date of your first visit. If, after 90 days, you still need treatment, and your employer provided a list as set forth above, you may change providers. Your bills will be paid if: 1) You notify your employer of this action within five days of your visit to the provider of your choice; and 2) Your chosen provider files reports within 21 days after your first visit and at least once a month for as long as treatment continues. If one of the providers listed above refers you to another licensed specialist, your employer or his insurer will pay for these services.

If you have a medical emergency, you may secure assistance from a hospital, physician, or practitioner of the healing arts of your choice. If your employer does not provide a list of Designated Licensed Health Care Providers, you may go to a licensed health care provider of your choice.
