

A Look at How Your Gifts Help

WellSpan VNA Home Care

Last year, WellSpan VNA Home Care served 9,441 patients by providing vital home care with expertise and compassion.

For more than 100 years, WellSpan VNA Home Care has understood that the best place to treat the body is where the heart is—at home. Often, when patients are recovering from an illness or accident, are disabled, have a chronic illness or are terminally ill, they do not need to be hospitalized but do need health care assistance.

WellSpan's specialized staff of nurses, aides, therapists, social workers, nutritionist, phlebotomists, and chaplain work with physicians to provide the services necessary to treat patients in the comfort of their own home.

Patient Support Fund

The Patient Support Fund relieves the financial pressures on patients who have needs that can impact their treatment or health outcomes. This fund helps at-risk patients with food, transportation, transitional housing and life-saving medications.



Food Insecurity

- Nearly 3,500 WellSpan patients in York County have been identified as food insecure.
- Your donation of \$50 provides a 3-day supply of meals for a food insecure patient upon discharge from the hospital.



Medication Assistance

- Help an average of 180 patients per month obtain life-saving medication.
- Your donation of \$100 helps two patients afford their medication each month.



Transportation Access

 Your donation of \$25 helps a patient get home from the hospital or to their follow-up appointment.

Heart & Vascular Research Fund

Support advances in medical innovation with a gift to the WellSpan Heart & Vascular Research Fund. WellSpan clinicians are identifying the newest and most effective treatment methods for cardiovascular disease through carefully designed and conducted clinical trials.

Forensic Examiner Program

The Forensic Examiner Program at WellSpan York Hospital provides comprehensive, trauma-informed care to individuals impacted by interpersonal trauma. Populations served by this team include sexually-assaulted adults and pediatrics, pediatric physical abuse, elder abuse, domestic violence, and human trafficking. Without intervention, interpersonal trauma may have lifelong after-effects impacting a person's physical and mental health.

In collaboration with our community partners, the forensic nursing specialty brings expertise to our region in the complex care needed for these individuals. Care is provided to minimize the long-term health consequences associated with interpersonal trauma.



Last year, the Forensic Examiner Program provided care to 762 patients.

Cancer Center Wellness Fund

Support the expansion of Supportive Care Services at WellSpan York Cancer Center. This fund will help offer massage therapies, pastoral care, yoga and meditation, holistic treatments, patient navigators, family conversation areas and an Appearance Center & Boutique at the Cancer Center.


Kids First Fund
