If you are appropriate for detox, White Deer Run will begin a bed search to look for treatment accommodations.</p> <p><b>DETOX NOT NEEDED?</b>            If you do not need medical assistance with managing the effects of stopping a substance but need an inpatient or outpatient rehab, call and make an appointment with a provider listed on the reverse for an assessment and a financial liability interview.</p> <p><b>Not Sure?</b>            Call the White Deer Run Call Center at 866-669-9502 for a short phone assessment.</p>
<p><b>PRIVATE PAY</b>            If you have the ability to pay for your drug and alcohol treatment, you may choose any facility you can afford.</p>
