WellSpan Health Blood Donor Services is seeking people who are fully recovered from the new coronavirus to help current COVID-19 patients.

People who have fully recovered from COVID-19 have antibodies in their plasma that can attack the virus. This convalescent plasma is being evaluated as treatment for patients with serious or immediately life-threatening COVID-19 infections.

You may qualify to donate plasma for coronavirus patients if you meet specific convalescent plasma and regular blood donation eligibility requirements:



1. **You must be in good health and eligible to be a volunteer community blood donor.**
2. **As part of the donation process, the donor center will perform blood tests on women with prior pregnancies to ensure that HLA antibodies are not present.**
3. **You must be able to show that you were diagnosed with COVID-19.**
 - a. **If you were tested at WellSpan, we can access your results for you.**
 - b. **If you were not tested at WellSpan, your doctor can complete a Physician Attestation Form or provide you with a copy of your laboratory test results.**
4. **You must be free of symptoms, specifically fever, due to COVID-19 for at least 28 days.**

If you're fully recovered from a new coronavirus infection and meet the above criteria, **please call the blood center** and say that you wish to make an appointment to give Convalescent Plasma. Your information will be given to the WellSpan Blood Donor Advocate who will contact you.
